



NOAC workshop on local government oversight

Today, Wednesday 5 November, the National Oversight and Audit Commission, Ireland's independent oversight body, hosted a workshop for the chairs of the local authority audit committees in Portlaoise.

The workshop brought together leaders from the local government sector, representatives from the Value for Money (VFM) unit of the Local Government Audit Service and representatives of the Department of Housing, Local Government and Heritage.

NOAC board member and event Chair, Margaret Lane, explained:

"We created this workshop to meet audit committee chairs in person, to inform them of NOAC's key priorities including the new Scrutiny Process and the latest NOAC reports.
